Did you guess "w"? Oh good. Now we can say "welcome" and answer your "w" questions:

who – Explorers are 4-to-6 year old children just like you
what – playing, learning, sharing, and caring
where – Explorers Portable and other inside and outside areas
when – after a sleep and before a dinner from Monday to Friday
why – with so much to do if you don't get started you'll never finish
Now for the rest of the alphabet because Explorers go from "a" to "z"

- A a is for area board: it shows places to play at Spare Time is for art: create it and take it home to stick on your fridge door is for attendance: say "here" when your name is called
- **B** b is for baking: learn about good food and how to mix and measure
 - is for **b**ooks: listen to stories, look at pictures, learn to read is for **b**uild: some things to stack and others to connect
- **C c** is for **c**ars: go "beep-beep" with four-on-the-floor is for **c**lean up: please put things back on the correct shelf is for **c**ubbie room: a place for your shoes, coat and backpack
- **D d** is for **d**ress up: wear stylish clothes and costumes
- **E e** is for **E**nglish: learn new words and practice language skills
- **F f** is for **f**ield trip: the Explorers in our bus go "here" and "there" is for **f**reeplay: listen to the choices then off to play
- **G** g is for games: surely you won't be bored by a board game
- **H h** is for **h**and: put a puppet on your hand and put on a show
- **I i** is for imagination: as Dr. Seuss wrote, "oh, the THINKS you can think!"
- **J j** is for **j**ump: reach for the ceiling in the gym, touch the sky outside **K k** is for **k**itchens: a real kitchen is for staff to prepare breakfast, lunch, and snack; a pretend kitchen is for Explorers to play in but

do not put the pretend food, cutlery and dishes in your mouth **L I** is for line up: stand in single file, face the front, be quiet, do not touch anyone, listen for instructions from the staff

M m is for music: sing, dance, play instruments

N n is for **n**ame tag: you have a name tag for your Area Board; put your name tag in the area where you are playing

O o is for oops: we all make mistakes and we all say "sorry" is for owie: tell a staff where it hurts

P p is for puzzles: place picture pieces perfectly - presto!

Q q is for **q**uiet time: relax by yourself – choose a comfy spot with silent ideas or a good book

R r is for respect: be kind to people and be careful with things is for rules: learn what to do so you can play safely

S s is for sharing: invite others to join in, take turns, be patient if you have to wait is for staff: people you and your family can trust; staff are here to help you have fun; you should always play where there is a staff is for stranger: people you and your family do not know; do not talk to a stranger

T t is for time away: a chance to sit, get calm, sort out a problem **U u** is for **u**nderstanding: be sure you understand all the rules; if you don't understand something ask staff for help

V v is for visit: go to our Imagination Station Portable to dance
W w is for walk: walk inside and keep your feet on the ground – running and climbing are only done outside is for words: use "polite words like: "please, thank you, excuse me"; use "sharing" words like "may I play, it's your turn, may I use that when you are finished"; use "I'm happy" words like "yippee, I feel good"; use angry words like "I don't like that, stop it" instead of hitting somebody

 \boldsymbol{X} \boldsymbol{x} is for $\boldsymbol{x} \circ \boldsymbol{x} \circ \boldsymbol{x}$: save your kisses (\boldsymbol{x}) for your family

Y y is for **y**ucky: playground mud puddles will make your clothes dirty – we only have a small collection of extra clothes so at certain times of the year it helps if you keep a change of clothes in your cubby is for **y**ummy: good food and juice (both fruit and the "moo" kind) at snack

Z z is for **z**ipper: do up your coat, pants and backpack
