It was fun because I was playing with my friend.

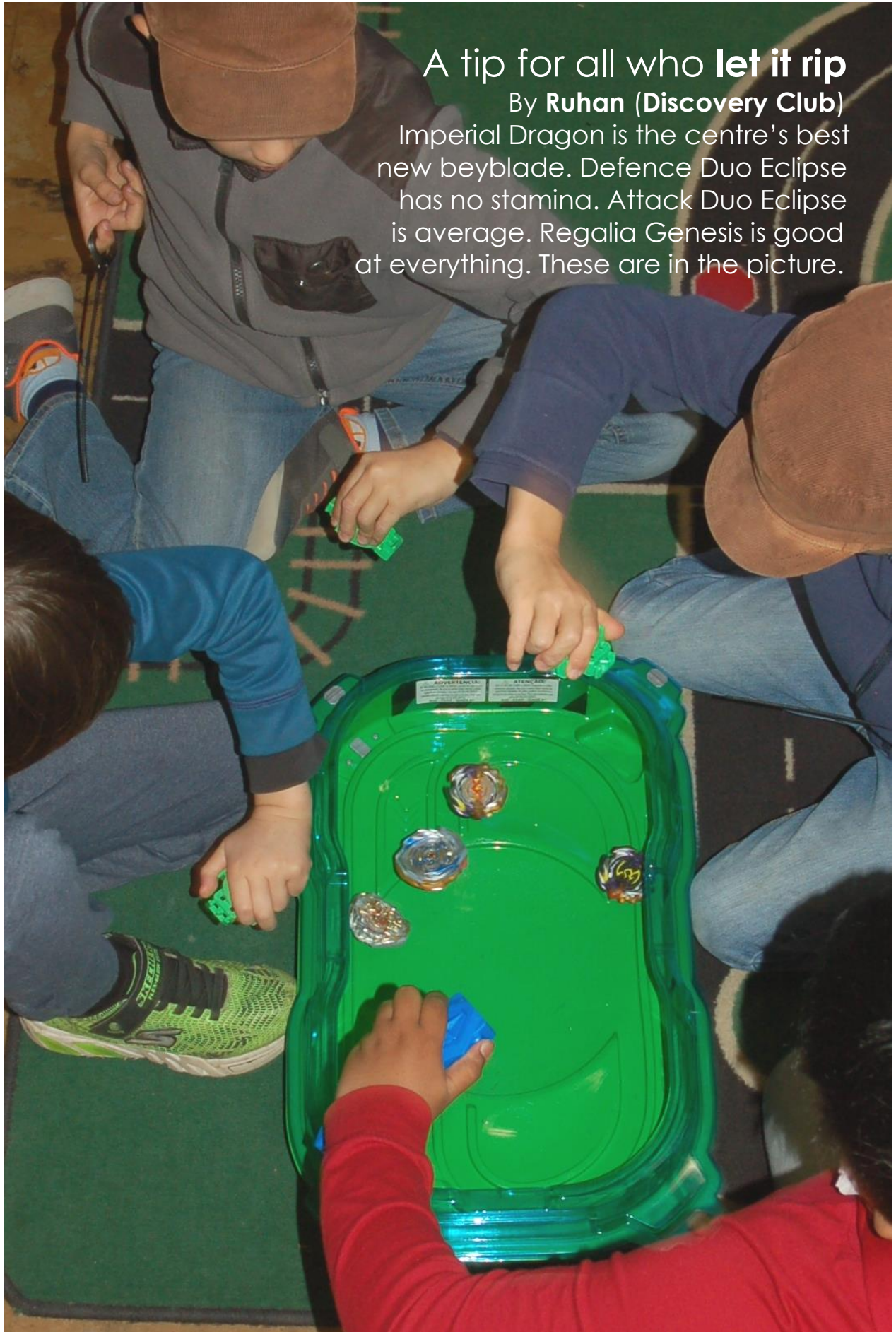

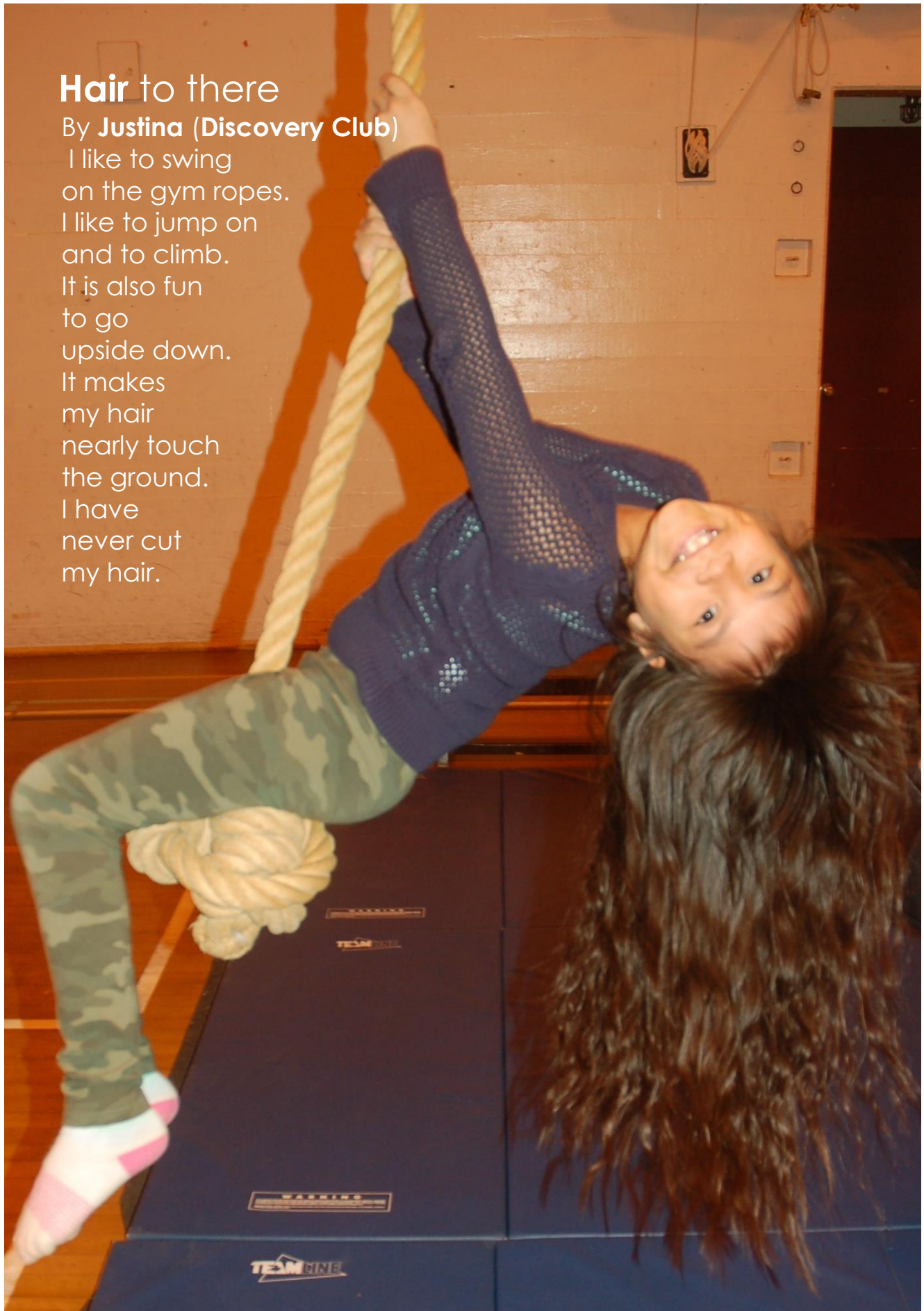

it twirls.



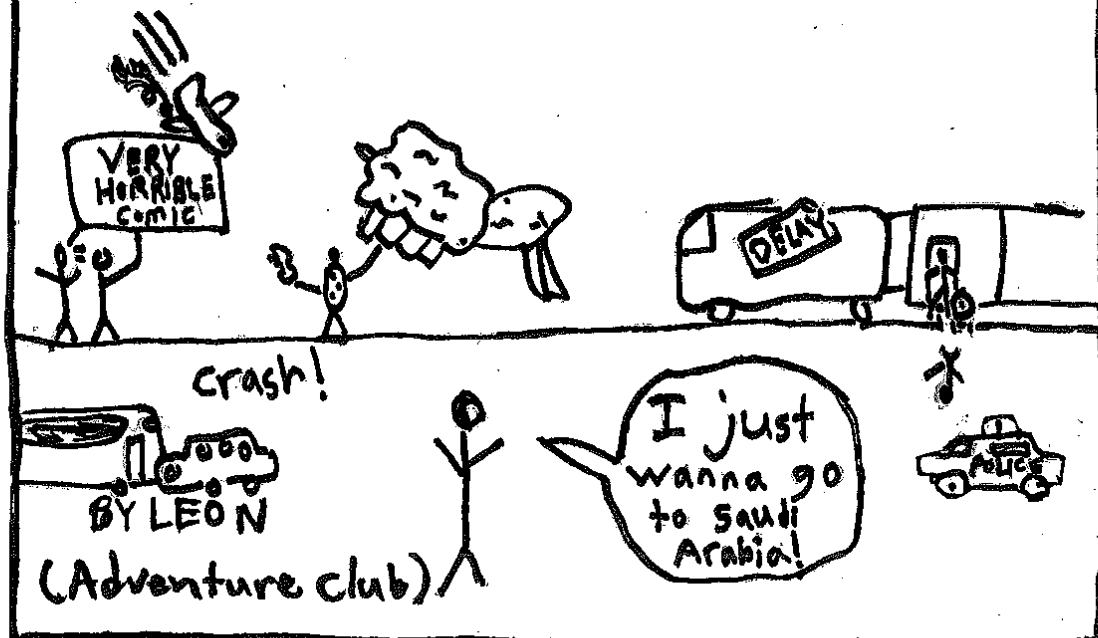


Cookie cash for charity
